The following COVID-19 guidance is provided in accordance with North Carolina Governor's Office, NC State University, and Gaston County Government:

- 1. The Lucile Tatum Center is currently open to the public by appointment only and individuals must wear a face covering.
- 2. Specialty interest groups can hold meetings and do personal projects inside the building.
- 3. All meetings are to be scheduled and require a staff member to be present.
- 4. Meetings are limited to 10 individuals or less, and social distancing is required. Note: No visitors permitted to attend these meetings at this time.

Call to order at 10 AM by Audrey Hunt, President.

Attending: Audrey Hunt, Linda Minges, Patti Wells, Billie Taylor, Pam Myers, Dana Croston, Billie Taylor.

Dana Croston gave Treasurer's Report. She will check on \$ to Something Pumpkin so we can be put on the t-shirts for advertisement. Money was finally received from ON The Border fundraiser!!

There were discussions on:

Cookbook Project: Dana is going to review material and see if this will be cost effective to do as a fundraiser.

Pastry Lady Fundraiser (October). This is a good fundraiser project and will be discussed later on in the year.

Patti Wells reported that the Rada online sale is set up now on the ECA Website and you can share it on your own page.

The Board toured the project room (old ceramic room) to see how it can be utilized. It was suggested that we pain the shelves to brighten up the room. Linda Minges said we would have to do it, county will not. (any volunteers?).
