

### 2021 SOMETHIN' PUMPKIN COOKING CONTEST RULES/INFO

- 1. Online registration at: eventbrite.com (find: 7th Annual Somethin' Pumpkin Festival) is due by October 1st. Email recipe to: somepumpkin15@gmail.com by October 1st. Recipes cannot be changed after the registration deadline.
- 2. Each person can enter only one recipe per category. Cooking Contest includes both adult and youth categories:

### Adult categories:

- Main Dish\* soups, salads, sandwiches, and casseroles
- Desserts\* cakes, breads, cookies, pastries & tarts
- Miscellaneous\* beverages, appetizers, low-calorie, etc.

## Youth categories:

- Youth (ages 8-12) -Main Dish & Miscellaneous
- Youth (ages 8-12) Desserts
- Youth (ages 13-18) Main Dish & Miscellaneous
- Youth (ages 13-18) Desserts
- 3. Recipes must feature significant amounts of pumpkin and have a distinctive pumpkin flavor. Due to food safety concerns, <u>no home-canned</u> pumpkin is allowed to be used in recipes. Recipes can include: fresh pumpkin, commercially canned pumpkin, or frozen pumpkin.
- 4. Judging will be based on Taste (40%), Originality (30%), Appearance (20%), and Texture (10%). The decision of judges will be final.
- 5. All entries are held at room temperature. Entries <u>will not</u> be refrigerated, heated, or held on ice after registration drop-off.
- 6. **Optional:** Please consider taking a photo of the contestant with his/her pumpkin dish to be included in the recipe booklet. Email photo of contestant and pumpkin dish to: somepumpkin15@gmail.com before dropping off your dish.
- 7. All contestants must use inexpensive, disposable storage containers for all entries as listed below:
  - Main dishes and casseroles: should be placed in a disposable container, such as aluminum baking pans or all-in-one pans designed for preparing, baking, and storing (such as Glad® OvenWare or other brands).

- Baked goods (i.e., cakes, breads, cookies): should be placed on a sturdy disposable plate, sheet of cardboard, plastic platter, etc., and fully wrapped or boxed.
- **Soups, salads, stews, and dips:** should be placed in a sturdy disposable container. For items that are warm, please use heat-resistant containers.
- All dishes need to come "display ready" you will not be able to set up your own dish/display.
- Contestants do not need to provide serving utensils.
- 7. Quantity to submit for various foods:
  - Yeast Breads & Quick Breads 1 mini loaf or 4 rolls
  - Biscuits 4 individual biscuits
  - Cakes 1 mini loaf or 4 slices
  - Candies 4 pieces
  - Cookies 4 individual cookies
  - Cupcakes 4 individual cupcakes
  - Entrees 4 x 4-inch container or 2 cups
  - Soups & Salads one quart or 4 cups

Contestants are to bring the prepared dish to the Lucile Tatum Center, located at 959 Osceola St., Gastonia, between 9 - 10AM, Saturday, October 23rd. Full details about drop-off will be provided to contestants upon registration. Contestants will not be allowed to enter the set-up area where judging is held.

- 9. All food entries become the property of NC Cooperative Extension and will be displayed as part of event festivities. *Entries will not be returned to you at the end of the event.*
- 10. Winners will be announced on Saturday, October 23rd during the Virtual Awards Presentation (1 2 PM).
- 11. Prizes will be awarded in each category as follows: first prize \$100; second prize \$50; third prize \$25. A grand prize of \$200 will be awarded to the overall contest winner. Checks prizes will be mailed to winners by the Gaston Co. Farm Bureau.
- 12. NC Cooperative Extension has the right to use the recipes at its discretion. Recipes will be posted on NC Cooperative Extension's website (www.gaston.ncsu.edu) by November 19, 2021.
- 13. This contest is intended for amateur cooks only. Professional chefs or those who earn a significant portion of their income from cooking may not enter the contest.
- 14. Employees of NC Cooperative Extension and Farm Bureau are ineligible to participate in the Somethin' Pumpkin Cooking Contest.
